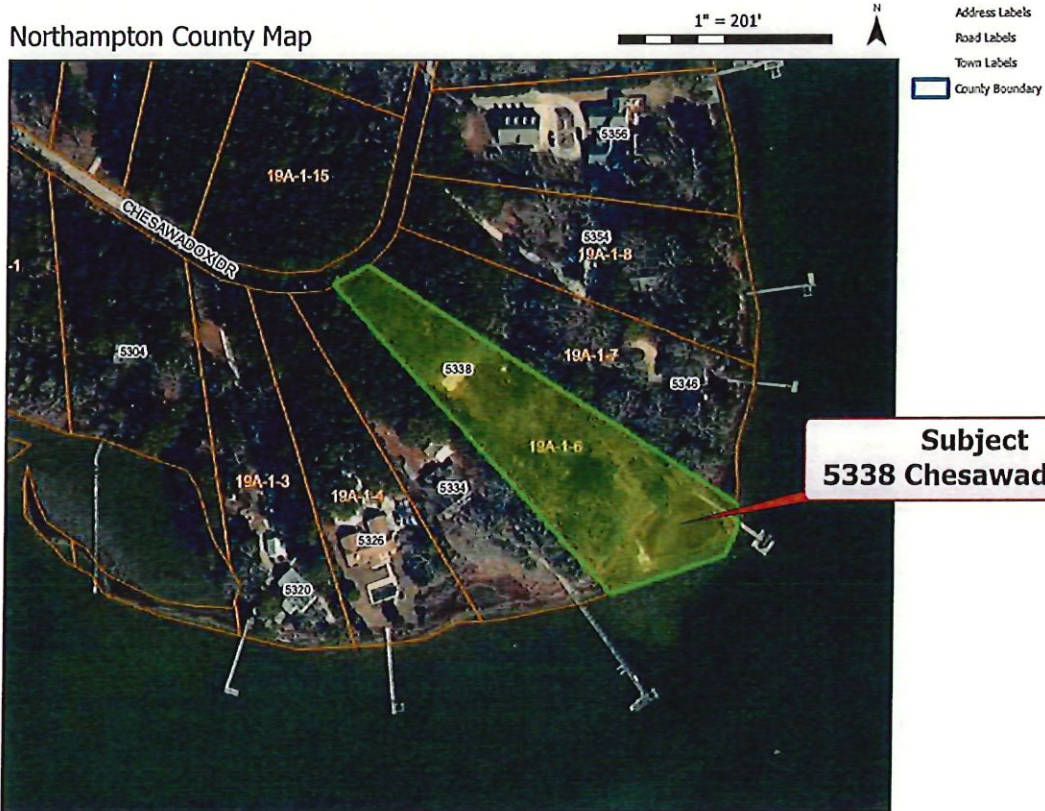

Northampton County Map

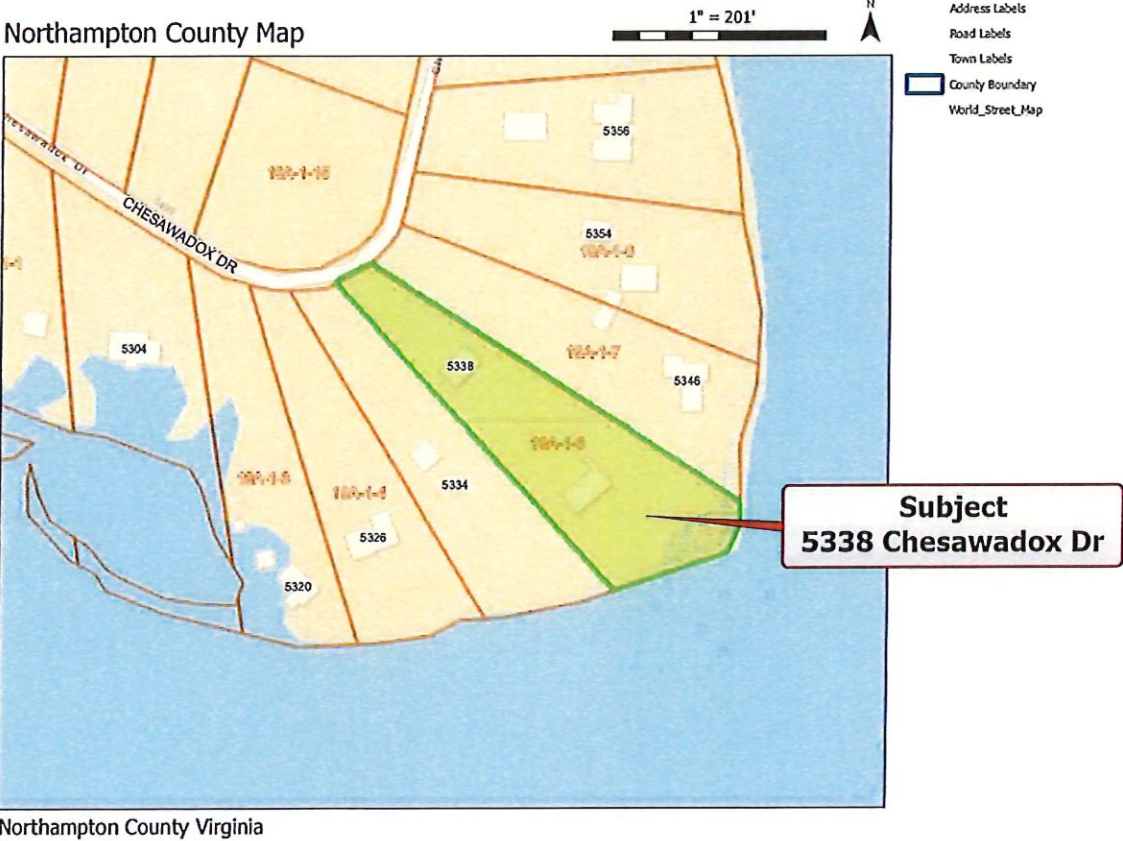

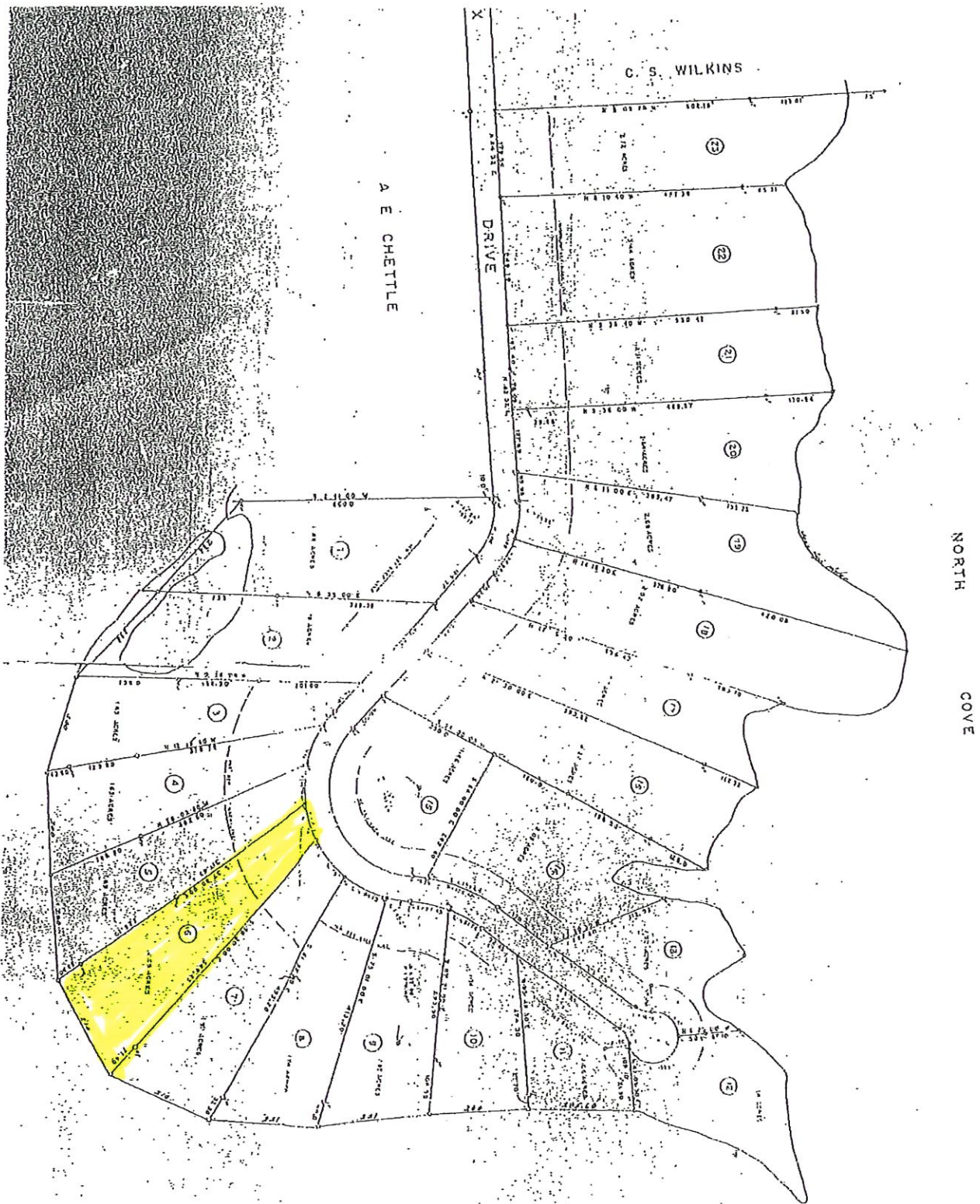

Restrictions

Deed Book 171 page 99

Subject to the following restrictions and covenants, which restrictions and covenants shall run with the land and shall be enforceable for a period of thirty-five (35) years from the date.

1. The property hereby conveyed shall not be sub-divided and shall be used for none other than single family residential purposes.
2. No mobile home or house trailer shall be maintained or permitted on said property. No out building or structure of a temporary character shall be used as a dwelling.
3. Each parcel of land shall be restricted to the building of one single family dwelling. The minimum living space requirement for any dwelling erected on said property shall be one thousand four hundred square feet (1,400 sq. ft.), exclusive of garage or carport and porches.
4. Each lot owner agrees to permit each other lot owner to develop and maintain adequate boating access to his property, and to give such approvals as necessary to any governing body which has jurisdiction in such matters.
