

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET

Pelican Inlet Condominiums - As of 1/2025

Q: What are my voting rights in the condominium association?

A: On all matters on which the membership is entitled to vote there is one vote for each unit.

Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?

A: Restrictions upon use of the condominium and condominium units are set forth in Article 18 of the Declaration of Condominium, and in the Rules and Regulations that may from time to time be promulgated by the Board of Administrations.

Q: What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on the leasing of my unit?

A: See page two of the Rules & Regulations.

Q: How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my unit and when are they due?

A: \$490 per month through December 31, 2025.

Q: Do I have to be a member in any other association? If so, what is the name of the association and what are my voting rights in this association? Also, how much are my assessments?

A: NO.

Q: Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other commonly used facilities? If so, how much am I obligated to pay annually?

A: NO

Q: Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court cases in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000? If So, identify each such case.
